

Highlights of November 2010 Session Meeting

- * Elder Molly Atkinson was endorsed as an Inquirer. This is the first step toward the possibility of her being ordained as a Minister of Word and Sacrament in the PC(USA). Her essay answers (a required part of this step of the process) were provided to session members in advance. The session met with her via *Skype*. Elder Lisa Kolb was appointed her liaison to the Committee on Preparation for Ministry of Mid-Kentucky Presbytery.
- * Approved a motion from the Finance/Stewardship Committee to establish an Investment Committee.
- * Recommended that the Terms of Call for both pastors for 2011 remain unchanged as noted in the draft 2011 budget. The session will bring this to the congregation at the Called Meeting on December 12, 2010 following worship.
- * Approved the 2011 Budget after reviewing what session members heard from members at the congregational forum on the budget.
- * Christian Education: Approved a request from the Tweens Sunday school class to let the children of the Sunday School ask the congregation for specific items or for money to support their Christmas mission project. The project will support clients of The Center for Women and Families.
- * Approved \$1,200 to be allocated to *Kinesis*, the presbytery's new ministry to college age youth, to be paid from the Browinski Fund in 2011.
- * Annual report on the church's Property and Liability Insurance coverage, as required by the *Book of Order* was received for information.
- * Annual report on the teachers and curriculum in the Christian Education Program, listing educational opportunities, curriculum and teachers, as required by the *Book of Order* was received for information.
- * Report on the Monday, November 15, 2010, 10:00 a.m. meeting of Mid-Kentucky Presbytery at Central Presbyterian Church: Appreciation was expressed to all the Central volunteers who made this day a success – most especially to Elder Humphrey Marshall who recruited and coordinated the volunteers and supervised the serving of the luncheon.
- * Removed inactive members as recommended by the pastors: Bruce Bell, Russ Coulter and Sara Dean.
- * Cancelled the December 2010 Stated Session Meeting on recommendation of the pastors.
- * Membership Report: 176 members; 4 affiliate members; 20 clergy friends = 200
- * Average Worship Attendance Report: October 2010 = 133 (October 2009 = 119)
